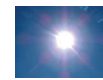


Senior Warden in the West

Greetings Brothers and thank to all who have submitted their dues for the current year however I am still carrying around 25 names on the roles of those who have yet to submit their dues. Please look at your dues card and if its says 'good through 12/31/2009', then you are in arrears. If that be the case then please submit your dues which are currently \$73.00.

As I hope everyone knows, we are no longer remitting the dues of those who have achieved 50 years or more membership in Masonry. Discontinuance of this practice was placed in effect on or about July 1, 2009 by Grand Lodge who pointed out that there is no provision in the California Masonic Code (CMC) allowing such practice. I aptly pointed out that we as a lodge had a long standing history of doing so and even provided documentation that effect. Grand Lodge cited that '...while that has been a noble and charitable practice you have been in violation of the CMC...'. Hence discontinuance of the practice by Tyrian Lodge.

If anyone is truly undergoing a financial hardship preventing them from paying the dues then please contact me as secretary or any of the three principal officer (Master, Senior or Juior Warden) and we will work with you to get you current on your dues.
